

## **Academic Action Reference Sheet**

This reference sheet is meant to be guidance related to the range of typical Academic Actions imposed as a result of a violation of DU's Academic Integrity Policies. The examples listed here do not address all possible violations of DU's Academic Integrity Policies or reflect all potential Academic Actions. The most appropriate Academic Action will likely depend on the nature of the situation and the number of times a student has engaged in the behavior.
