Records or new year exemption.



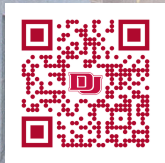
- Register for Classes**

The Health and Counseling Center (HCC) is your on-campus resource for quality medical and mental healthcare services, health education information, and support through transitions and challenges, conveniently located on-campus in the DU Ritchie Center.

Our Programs:

Medical Services provides (non-surgical) primary care, with labs, prescriptions, travel health, immunizations, specialist referrals, and more. Telehealth options are available.



Counseling Services provides professional, confidential support offered in-person and via telehealth. Offers support for individuals, couples, and provides groups and workshops.



CAPE provides no-cost, confidential advocacy and support for those impacted by interpersonal violence, such as sexual assault, relationship violence, stalking, and sexual harassment.



MyHealth Online Portal for easily scheduling appointments, secure messaging providers, and accessing HCC records. Providers available by phone 24/7 for urgent consultations.



Thrive Health Promotion offers no-cost health and wellbeing education, engagement, and sociocultural change focused on prevention and harm reduction strategies. Plus offers events, workshops, online resources, wellness coaching, and more!



The Student Health Fee (HCF) supports prevention education, wellness resources, and crisis support services available to all students. Especially with DU's Student Health Insurance Plan, the Fee helps minimize out-of-pocket expenses for campus health services.



Students are billed for the **DU Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP)** unless and until they submit a waiver request, demonstrating adequate alternative coverage. Optional (opt-in) vision and dental coverage is also available.
